Annual Grilling Benefit and Silent Auction Provides Scholarships and Grants for Local Women in Culinary and Hospitality Professions

AUSTIN, TX (APRIL 18, 2022) – Les Dames d'Escoffier of Austin is proud to bring back "You Grill Girl!," Austin's first event featuring women chefs and grilling masters, on Thursday, April 28 at Franklin Barbecue. First held in 2019 but then on hold during the pandemic, the fundraiser raises money for scholarships and grants for Austin women in the culinary, wine, food artisans and hospitality professions. To date, the Austin Dames chapter has awarded \$217,000 in scholarships.

"You Grill Girl!" will feature smoked and grilled dishes by some of Austin's most acclaimed female chefs along with raffles and a silent auction featuring an autographed directors chair from Julia Child, a private film screening at Violet Crown, a Franklin BBQ pit, a stay at Cactus Moon Lodge, large format food photography prints from Mackenzie Smith, Weige Knives, and many others.

"This event is a celebration of those women and of the ones who come after us. Held in the parking lot of Franklin Barbecue, 900 East 11th Street, from 7 p.m. – 10 p.m., all proceeds from ticket sales, raffles, silent auction, and sponsorships will benefit the scholarship program.

A few of the planned dishes from this year's chefs include nilgai cervelat sausage with thorny mustard and swiss sourdough, pork with sunchoke and fermented ramps, grilled catfish yakitori with grits and crawfish tare, lamb belly huraches, arroz con coco with pistachio and grilled carrots glazed with jaggery milk jam, and a smoked orange chicken taco with scallion pancake and tomatillo aioli.
